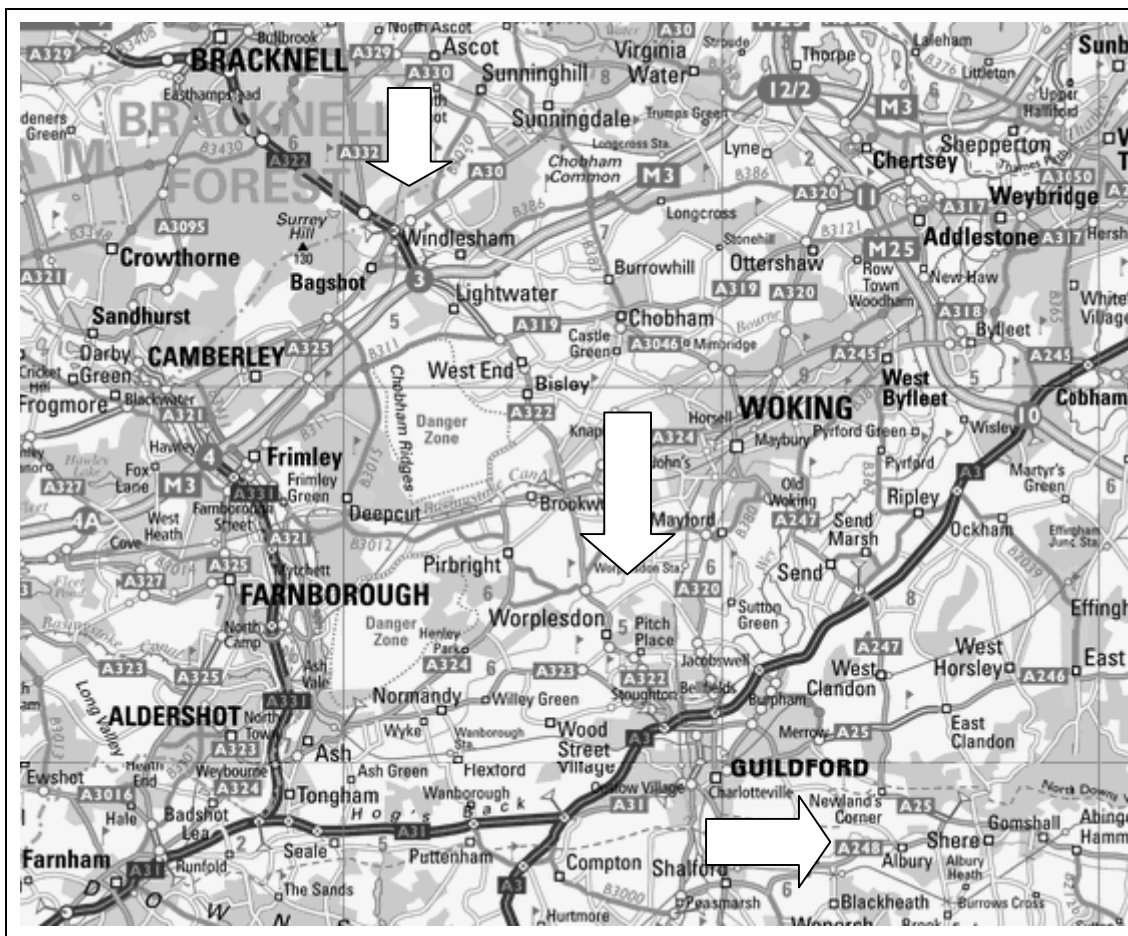


Bentley Copse is situated in the heart of the beautiful Surrey countryside, 2½ miles south of the picturesque village of Shere. Shere village is situated off the A25 between Guildford and Dorking. See bottom for postcode.



First get to Guildford.

Our suggested route is to use the A322 via Bagshot, Lightwater, West End, Bisley and Worplesdon.

On arrival at the Wooden Bridge roundabout in Guildford (under the A3) take the first exit (A25 towards Guildford). Stay on the dual carriageway past the Ladymead retail park, fire station and Spectrum Leisure Centre. At Boxgrove Crossroads roundabout take 2nd exit signed Dorking A25



Guildford to Shere

At the traffic lights turn left to follow the A25 signposted Dorking through Merrow. Turn right at the traffic lights near Clandon Park to then go up the hill, past Newlands Corner viewpoint and the Silent Pool/A248 junction.

At Shere leave the A25 and take the road into the village, signposted Shere and Ewhurst. In the middle of the village turn right (signed Bentley Copse) onto Middle Street which is very narrow.

Follow this road for 2½ miles. Bentley Copse Camp Site is on the left hand side once you get to the bit of the single track road with high earth banks each side. It is clearly signposted.

According to the AA Route Planner, this 25 mile journey should take around 50 minutes. OS Map Reference: TQ 07454425, Postcode GU5 9JH
