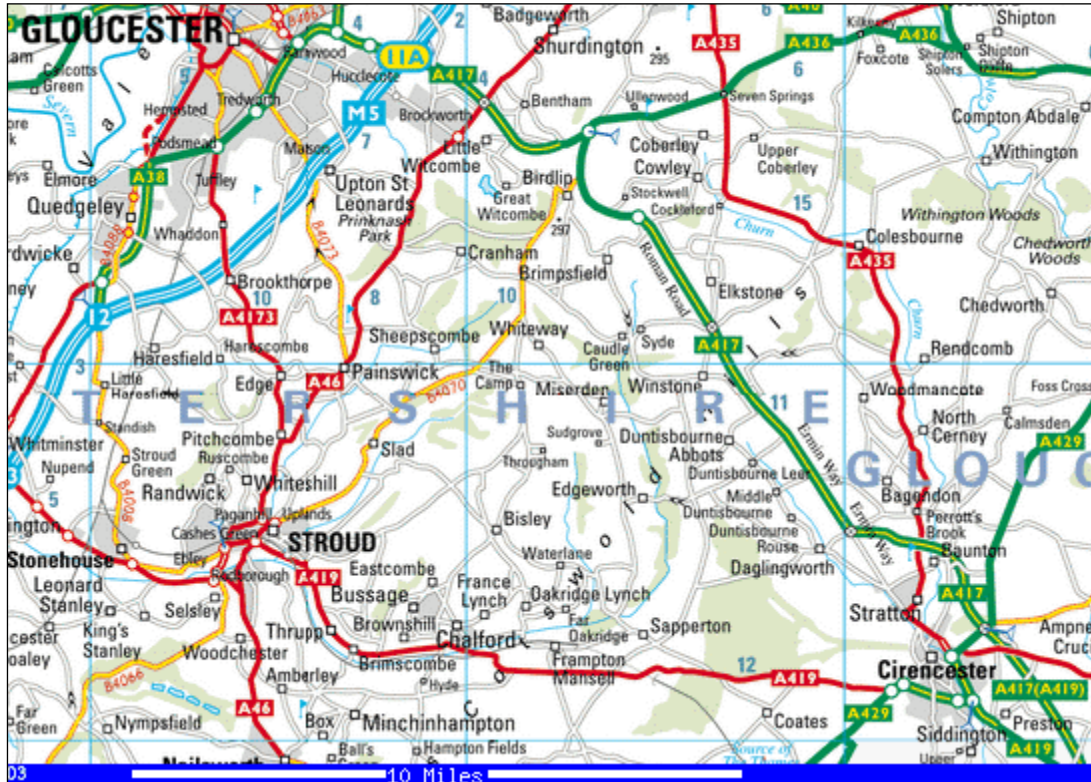


## How to get to Cranham

Cranham is located in Gloucestershire. It is a small village just off the main A46 Stroud to Cheltenham road. If you can work out grid references then look up SO 895 132 or alternatively just type Cranham into one of the online map sites such as [www.multimap.co.uk](http://www.multimap.co.uk). Postcode: GL4 8HP

### Directions from Bracknell

- First leg is to Swindon via the M4
- At M4 junction 15 leave the motorway and join the A419 signposted to Cirencester/Gloucester
- At South Cerney stay on the dual carriageway which becomes A417 and continue towards Gloucester
- When you see the sign to Birdlip and the viewpoint continue on the A417 until you come to the roundabout by the Air Balloon pub
- Take first exit to stay on A417 and go down the hill
- At the next junction join the A46 towards Stroud



- After about 3 miles look out for the signs to Prinknash Abbey on your right. At a further ½ mile turn (very sharp) left - signposted Birdlip and Cranham.

- After 50 yards turn right signposted - Cranham Scout HQ. Go down the steep, narrow hill for about a mile. The camp site is on the left just as you enter the village.
- Turn in by the Post Office sign and follow the road round into the car park by the toilet block. Park here and walk through the gate into the field.
